Ephraim Hoge Preliminary Plat

Mitch asks if the sign in sheet has been around to everyone. He then explains the rules for hearings.

Motion to go into hearing for the Ephraim Hoge Preliminary Plat was made by Albert Johnson, seconded by Kristie Crane, all in favor.

Ephraim Hoge explained his desire for this iteration of his development. When the planning commission approved his proposal the first time, it was with three lots. The planning commission encouraged him down to two lots with additional road width. Ephraim felt that if he had to widen the road, he might as well have the third lot. Health Department wants language on the plat allowing water or individual wells. This project has been reviewed by the engineer and administrator.

Comments from the crowd, Cade Gunig. Cade wants the plat to say; "public right of way not public utility easement". He also wants 6' of additional width.

Motion to close hearing was made by Albert Johnson, seconded by Kristie Crane, all in favor.

Page 2-November 14, 2018 - BL Planning & Zoning

After deliberation the planning commission comes up with the following conditions:

- 1. Ephraim to add gravel on the north of the existing road until the centerline north equals nine feet.
- 2. Public right of way to be identified from his southern property line to the north.
- 3. Lot sizes are to be no smaller than 1 acre.
- **Motion** to recommend approval of the Ephraim Hoge Preliminary and Final Plat to the county commissioners was made by Albert Johnson, second by Kay Beck, all in favor.

Legacy Beach Combined Preliminary and Final Plat

• Motion to go into public hearing for Wynn Hubrich's Legacy Beach preliminary and final plat made by Kristie Crane, seconded by Kay Beck, motion carried.

With no one in the audience to present testimony the time was directed to the applicant to explain his proposal. Wynn Hubrich gave the background on the development. There has been a slight change to the plat since the original was submitted. The change to the plat involved changing the eastern lot line to reflect the high water mark.
