

The Board of Bear Lake County Commissioners met in a special meeting on Monday, July 16, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. in the Bear Lake County Clerk's Office in Paris, Idaho. Members present were Commissioners Vaughn N Rasmussen, Chairman, Bradley D. Jensen, and Rex L. Payne. Scott Esquibel, County Superintendent and Amy Bishop, Chief Deputy Clerk, were also in attendance. Prosecuting Attorney Adam Mckenzie joined the meeting in progress.

Commissioner Brad Jensen moved to open the meeting. Commissioner Rex Payne seconded. Motion Carries.

The commissioners and Esquibel reviewed the text of a proposed new bid notice for the Paris Canyon crossing.

Commissioner Rasmussen suggested that the third paragraph be revised to clarify what the county will put the material on the road. Commissioner Payne requested language be added on meeting the engineered drawings and specifications.

There was significant discussion on the timeframe for the job to be completed. Factors included delivery timeframe for the materials, when the cattle will come off the forest, and hunting access. The timeframe will be September 17 to October 10.

Esquibel called the materials supplier to discuss delivery date.

The Commissioners directed Esquibel to e-mail the bid notice to those who have previously bid and Bishop to publish the notice twice.

Commissioner Rex Payne, made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Jensen seconded. The meeting was then adjourned.
